WHEREAS, the Department of Elder Affairs, alongside dedicated volunteers in programs such as the Serving Health Insurance Needs of Elders (SHINE), the Office of Public and Professional Guardians, and the Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program (LTCOP), tirelessly advocate for the safety and welfare of our cherished seniors; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Children and Families plays a crucial role in safeguarding vulnerable adults from abuse, neglect, exploitation, or self-neglect through the Adult Protective Services Program, preventing further harm and ensuring their well-being; and

WHEREAS, under the leadership of First Lady Casey DeSantis, Hope Florida empowers seniors by facilitating connections with private, nonprofit, and faith-based partners, ensuring their needs are comprehensively addressed, and enabling them to lead secure, independent lives; and

WHEREAS, Elder Abuse Awareness Day is an opportunity to raise awareness about elder abuse, neglect, and exploitation, reaffirming our commitment to safeguarding the dignity, health, and rights of our seniors.
